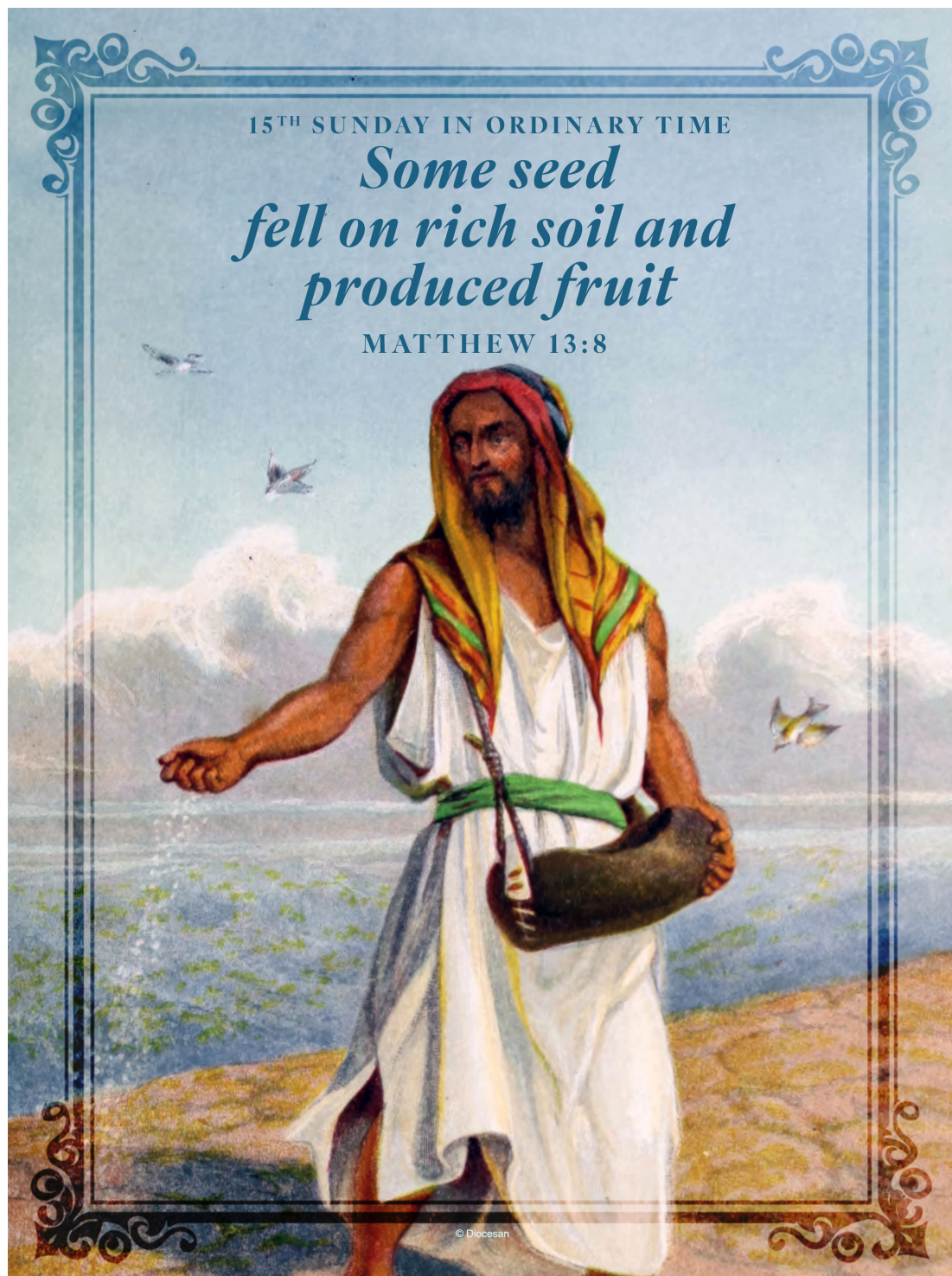

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. KATERI TEKAWITHA

The "Lily of the Mohawks" was born in the same village in which three of the North American martyrs met their deaths. Tekakwitha learned the traditional women's arts of her tribe: making clothing, weaving baskets, preparing food, and helping with crops. At seventeen, Tekakwitha's aunts pressured her to marry. She refused, suffering their taunts and punishments. This young woman who fell in love with the Lord despite the opposition of her family and clan is the first Native American to be canonized.

Her feast day is celebrated July 14th.

If you become aware of or have a reasonable suspicion of abuse you are required to report within 24 hours by Georgia law. Reports of child abuse and neglect can be made by phone to 1-855-GA CHILD (1-855-422-4453) 24 hours/day, 7 days/week. Archdiocesan policy requires a follow up letter to be sent to your local DFCS office detailing all the information provided to the intake center in order to keep records of our response to allegations of abuse. A copy of the letter also needs to be sent to the Office of Child and Youth Protection. If an allegation of abuse involves any member of the clergy, employee, or volunteer of the Archdiocese of Atlanta, you must contact the Office of the District Attorney and the Office of Child and Youth Protection in addition to DFCS within 24 hours.
